This event will be held under the General Competition Rules of the Motorcycle Union of Ireland and the Standing Regulations for Motocross, together with the following supplementary regulations and any other subsequently issued.

1. Eligibility: Open to M.C.U.I. (U/C & S/C), M.R.A., A.C.U., and S.A.C.U Licence holders and EU A & B Licence holders. All non M.C.I/M.R.A. Licence holders must have personal accident insurance confirmed by their own FMN.

Competitors must ensure they avail of their practice session/s. If sign-on and scrutiny has closed it will be re-opened only on payment of a fee of €10.00.

3. At "Check In" Competition Licences must be presented and the declaration form signed. One event licence may be obtained on production of a valid medical certificate or proof of having previously obtained a 1 event licence this year. Riders not in possession of a valid licence will not be accepted.
A 1 Day licence will be available on the day €20 per licence.
4. Riders must ensure that they avail of practice/qualifying before the race.
5. Only M.C.I./M.R.A. Approved helmets (2017 stamped) and protective clothing permitted.
6. It is the responsibility of the rider to present and maintain their machines in race worthy condition. Scrutineering will consist of checking compliance with M.C.I. Safety requirements.
7. Un-necessary or inconsiderate Riding or Driving in the paddock or spectator area is prohibited and may entail disqualification from the event. This also applies when racing has finished. There is no riding in the paddock and or track except in and during a race or sighting lap.
8. Starting will be by "Clutch Start" controlled by flag.
9. Races – 3 Races per Group
10. Riders ignoring flags or other official signals may be penalised.
11. Each rider has to have a transponder to count in result table. If you require a transponder you can rent one on the race day.
12. Riders who deliberately cut the course or knock down markers will be disqualified.
13. All Riders must display correct and legible numbers. Some riders may be required to change numbers.
14. Safety Requirements: A fire extinguisher must be available for each machine. Petrol supplies must be stored in metal containers.
15. The East Cork Motorcycle Club Ltd reserves the right to refuse entry without stating the reason, to alter or cancel any or all foregoing riders and to issue further supplementary regulations and/or instructions.
16. If the race is stopped because of the rider lying on the course, that rider will not be allowed to restart the race.
17. Any rider refusing medical attention will not be allowed to race further on the day.
18. No Scooters, Bicycles, Minibikes or Quads will be permitted at the venue
19. Prize-money: Awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall 'A' Riders in Group 1 only. Trophies for all other Grades.

ENTRY FEE: **Youth €30** (prepaid)/€40 (on race day)

Adult €45 (prepaid)/€55 (on race day)

Closing date for postal entries will be Tuesday, 20th June 2017. Please have entries in on time or a late fee may occur. Please make Cheques and Postal Orders payable to East Cork Motorcycle Club – Competitors are requested to include the fee with their entry. NOTE: No cheques will be accepted on race day. All dogs must be kept on a lead while in the paddock, and must not be allowed on the track. This is to ensure the safety of all persons attending the meeting and to comply with insurance regulations. Those staying at the track on Friday and Saturday night must also obey this rule. For overnight parking noise levels must be kept to a minimum after 10pm. All generators must be turned off at 10pm.
