Venue: Dundalk Motocross Park, Kilcurry, Dundalk, Co. Louth.

This event will be held under the General Competition Rules and Standing Regulations for Motocross / Grasstrack of the Motor Cycle Union of Ireland, (The rules of the Championship), together with the following supplementary regulations and any others subsequently issued:

1. Eligibility: Open to M.C.I. (U/C & S/C), M.R.A., A.C.U., and S.A.C.U. licence holders, and EU A&B licence holders. All non M.C.I./ MRA licence holders must have personal accident insurance confirmed by their own FMN.
2. Times: Check-in and scrutiny 7.30 – 09.00am., Sat & Sun
3. Riders arriving after scrutiny has closed will be charged a late fee of €15 for it to be reopened.
4. Riders must ensure they avail of a practice session.
5. At Check-in, the indemnity form must be signed and current competition licence presented.
6. Riders not in possession of a licence will not be permitted to race.
7. Only M.C.I. / M.R.A. approved helmets (2017 stamped) and protective clothing permitted.
8. It is the responsibility of the riders to present and maintain their machines in raceworthy condition. Scrutineering will consist of checking compliance with M.C.I. requirements.
9. Unnecessary or inconsiderate riding or driving in the paddock or spectator area is prohibited and may entail disqualification from the event. This also applies when racing has finished.
10. Starting will be by "Clutch Start" controlled by a mechanical gate or other approved apparatus.
11. Riders ignoring flags or other official signals may be penalised.
12. Riders who deliberately cut the course or knock down markers will be disqualified.
13. All machines must display three correct and legible Southern Centre numbers. Some riders may be required to change numbers. All machines must be fitted with a transponder.
14. Safety requirements: A fire extinguisher must be available for each machine. Petrol supplies must be stored in metal containers. Inspection of fire extinguishers and petrol containers will be carried out.
15. The Dundalk Motocross Club Ltd. reserves the right to refuse an entry without stating a reason, to alter or cancel any or all of the foregoing and to issue further supplementary regulations and/or instructions.
16. Riders will be called for marshalling duties. Each rider must provide a Marshall.
17. If a race is stopped because of a rider lying of the course, that rider will not be allowed to restart the race.
18. Any rider refusing medical attention will not be allowed to race further on the day.
19. No scooters, bicycles, minibikes or quads will be permitted at this venue.
20. Youth riders must wear approved neck braces as per youth guidelines 2017.
21. Any rider wishing to withdraw their entry, must do so by email ddmcc25@gmail.com, or contact the club (speaking to someone) on (042) 9326539 by 9pm the evening before the event.
22. €5.00 payable at gate by all competitors.

Late entries will be charged an extra €10 on the day.

Entries must be in writing, on the official entry form.

Entries not on Official Entry Form will not be accepted.

Adults: Entries must be accompanied by a full entry fee. If they are not, the rider will be treated as a late entry (see above).

Please make cheques and postal orders payable to **D.D.M.C.C. Ltd.** Competitors are requested to include the fee with their entry.

No deposits will be accepted after the closing date.

N.B. All competitors in the case of adults and parents/guardians of competitors in the case of juniors are responsible for all persons and animals accompanying them. All children must be kept under supervision at all times. All dogs must be kept on leads while in the paddock, and must not be allowed on to the track. This is to ensure the safety of all persons attending the meeting, and to comply with insurance regulations.

Those staying at the track on Friday and Saturday night must also obey this rule; otherwise this facility will be removed for future events.
