Motorcycling Ireland (southern centre) Code of procedure for race numbers 2015.

The following is the procedure for riders' preferred numbers which applies between Nov 15 and Dec 31 of the year previous to racing. The reason for this is to give riders an opportunity to apply for their numbers in advance of the new season. Race licences applied for from Jan 1 on will be allocated racing numbers on a random basis. (i.e. you won't be able to pick your number for 2015 after Jan 1st 2015) Please note that you will still have to apply for a 2015 competition licence.

Description

No rider "owns" any number.

The centre will issue a new number to each licence holder each year which may or may not be the same number as the previous year.

A rider can request a number subject to qualification (previous years' SC MX Championship position) and on a first come, first served basis.

Numbers must be applied for by email only not before Nov 15 and not after Dec 31. This is to allow for Southern Centre results to be ratified at AGM in early November and for traceability in first come-first served from Nov 15 to Dec 31.

Effort will be made to keep a riders number the same as the previous year but again subject to qualification and again on a first come first served basis.

All riders will be issued one race number for 2015, to race in MCI events; the rider must display this number only in every race.

No duplicates shall exist between classes (adults)

Duplicates can happen between youth classes although not in 85s and 125/250s.

Adult numbers shall run as follows:

Southern Centre A riders 1 to 99

Southern Centre B riders 100 to 199

Southern Centre C riders 200 and up

Adult Irish championship A class winners in the past 10 years will have first choice of number in the order of the most recent winner backwards.

The first 20 numbers shall be given out as an option in the A class only as per final championship positions in the Southern Centre Motocross Championship the previous year as follows:

MX1 Odd numbers, MX2 even numbers.

Specific numbers can be applied for to the MX convenor/committee between ratification of results at MCI agm (from 15 November to December 31). Application should be made to the convenor by email MX1MMG@gmail.com between these dates. In the event of two riders wanting the same number, early date of application and championship position shall determine the preference.

The MX convenor shall supply the race numbers to the MCI office for attachment to competition licences from Mid November until Dec 31. After this date, the numbers will be allocated by the MCI office on a random basis

Youth Numbers:

Again all choices based on previous year's SC results and must be made between Nov 15 and Dec 31 by email to MX1MMG@gmail.com

Automatic class: 1 to 99

Numbers1 -10 Restricted for top 10 finishers in this class the previous year.

65cc: Numbers 1 to 99

Numbers 1 to 10 Restricted for top 10 finishers in the 65s the previous year

Small and Big wheels together Numbers 1 -99

Small wheel 85/150cc: Numbers 11 to 20 restricted to top 10 finishers in the small wheels the previous year

Big wheel 85/150cc: Numbers 1 to 10 restricted to top 10 finishers in the big wheels the previous year.

125 2 stroke and 250 4 stroke together Numbers 1 -99

125cc: Numbers 11 -20 restricted to top 10 finishers in this class the previous year 250cc: Numbers 1 -10 restricted to top 10 finishers in this class the previous year.
